Spelling Bee General Information

- The spelling bee will be held **Saturday, February 16 at 2:00 PM** in the Library Community Room. *All members of a team should arrive at least 10 minutes before the event begins.* The entire bee is expected to last about 90 minutes.
- Rather than a traditional “spell it wrong and you’re out” format, the spelling bee is point based.
- The competition consists of six rounds. Words will become progressively harder with each round.
- For most rounds, team members will discuss and agree on the spelling of the given word. Certain rounds may require a designated team member to spell a word without the aid of other team members.
- Use of smart phones, tablets, or any other aids during the competition is prohibited, as is consulting audience members. Any team caught seeking outside help or otherwise cheating will be disqualified.
- The winning team will advance to a Regional Spelling Bee to compete against winning teams from other libraries in the North Texas area. The event will be held in Spring 2019—more details will be announced soon.
