What is Summer Reading?

It's our way of encouraging reading so that kids and teens are ready for school in the fall and that adults continue to learn and set a good example for their families. Anyone who registers will have opportunities to win prizes just for reading! It's completely free to participate and there are no strings attached!

This year's theme is: *A Universe of Stories!* It's all about outer space and expanding your horizons!

How Summer Reading Works:

- The Adult Summer Reading Club is open to adults ages 18 and older.
- Register at our Kickoff Party on June 7th - OR - register at the Information Desk during Library hours after June 7th. You will be given additional instructions and a reading log to track how much you read. (Any reading counts, including novels, ebooks, audiobooks, textbooks, magazines, newspapers, and even reading to your children!)
- Once you've read 5 hours, bring your log to the Information Desk, and you'll receive a prize! Additional prizes, such as a free book or raffle tickets towards gift cards, are awarded at 10 hours, 15 hours, and every 5 hours after!
