REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVICE

- ~ Heartworm prevention can only be prescribed after the pet receives a negative heartworm test administered by TCAP.
- ~ We accept Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and cash as payment.
- ~ All dogs must be on a tight leash for the safety of your pet and other clients and their pets.
- ~ All cats must be in a hard-sided carrier.
